## **GS1.1**

- No success with the new owner for Holt Manor. Can only see that money in the end will win.
- Grass/meadows grown for silage need to be protected from many trampling feet. Footpaths through these areas at certain times of year need clear signage to request keeping to the

footpath.

• Have early consultation with new land owners about footpaths.

## **GS1.2**

- Possibly add cycleways?
- In particular, I would like improved access to the river and a riverside walk. Also, more off-road cycle paths, to Melksham, Trowbridge and Bradford on Avon.
- Reinstate FP57 which was closed for a foot-and-mouth epidemic long forgotten. This would give safe pedestrian access to Broughton Gifford, Whaddon and Melksham(x2).
- Possible upgrade to cycleway?

#### **GS2.1**

- Some provision should be made for lesser green spaces the little green and narrow green, to be used to provide parking at some point in the future.
- Investigate whether all green spaces ought to be designated as assets of community value.

#### **GS2.2**

- Suggest clarify which land is "green belt" (formal designation) and which is green field(x2).
- The area around the village is not Green Belt except for the Western end.
