TANNERY SITE REDEVELOPMENT

Introduction

As many of you may be aware from the article in the December issue of Holt Magazine, an initial planning application has been submitted to re-develop the Beaven's old Tannery site in the Midlands. This application has been rejected, but it does not mean that the issue has gone away, and shows that a future development is a distinct possibility.

Although at present we do not know what shape any final plans might take, the site has been identified by Wiltshire Council as an 'Area of Opportunity' which means that any development must be a mix of both housing and business premises.

If the community of Holt is to influence the planning process, it is essential that the Parish Council supplements the information it has already collected with data specific to this site. This Questionnaire is a major part of that process and we urge you to respond. If you respond you still retain your right to make individual representations about any proposed development.

Purpose of the questionnaire and confidentiality

The information gathered in this Questionnaire will only be used to inform the Parish Council of the opinions of the community. All data will be securely held and will be destroyed when it is no longer required. It is fine to complete and return the Questionnaire anonymously, but if you would like to become more involved, please do give us your name and address at the end.

Personal information will only ever be presented on a statistical basis primarily to establish the representativeness of the respondents. No individuals, or small group of individuals, will be identified.

We are delivering two copies per household. Every resident is eligible to complete a Questionnaire and each household will receive two copies initially. We will leave it to parents/guardians to judge if children and young people should be given their own copy. Please complete as much of the Questionnaire as you can, even if a question does not seem relevant to you or you are not able to answer every question.
