

Holt Neighbourhood Plan - Traffic Plan - Local Business Survey

Under the new Localism Bill, the Holt Neighbourhood Plan is currently being developed in conjunction with Holt Parish Council and Wiltshire Council. This will consider the next ten to fifteen years of growth in the village, and the resulting issues. Once ratified, it will form a legal consultation document for future planning.

Increasing traffic, sufficient parking facilities for residents and visitors, and pedestrian safety have been identified as key issues. A separate Traffic Plan committee has been formed to investigate the current situation and the future plans of key stakeholders, and thus propose long term solutions to meet these needs. After public consultation, this document will be incorporated into the wider Neighbourhood Plan for adoption.
