Dear Parish Council,

As you may be aware, the Holt Safari Supper set a target over the summer to raise funds for village projects. This was our first year 'under new management' and we're pleased to say we've raised circa 850GBP.

We recognise this isn't an earth shattering amount, but we hope participation and the funds raised will grow over the coming years.

We're keen to invest the funds in projects that are visible in the village so that villagers can see a direct link to participation in the event and improvements in the village in a similar way the Scarecrow Trail team supported our lovely new benches.

Our initial thought was to support some tree planting around the village. We could organise the trees and plant them over the winter.
