Why Review the Neighbourhood Plan?



Changing Needs

An updated plan will reflect the current needs of residents, including housing, recreational spaces, and community services. It will be used and taken account of in planning decisions for planned development.



Environmental issues

The review provides an opportunity to integrate more environmentally friendly practices and protect our green spaces.



Your views on traffic, planning, and anything else

A fresh review encourages active participation from residents. Holt Parish Council will use the Neighbourhood Plan to understand the priorities and concerns of Holt residents.



Enhanced Local Infrastructure

A well-structured plan could attract investment and guide developments that improve local infrastructure—transport links, public spaces, or community facilities.

Steering Group
